Dear Families

End of year report

We are delighted to be able to share your child's end of year report for 2024/25 which details their achievements and areas for development. These will be sent home with the children today.

In putting together your child's report, their teacher has made judgements around their attainment and their learning behaviours.

Teachers use a range of information to arrive at judgements around your child's attainment. This will be a combination of outcomes from assessments or tests, as well as information gathered during lessons since September 2024. We report on the basis of where your child sits against National Curriculum expectations for their year group.

Parents of children in Y6 will have received SATs results which are based purely on the tests which took place in May.

The table below sets out the 'best fit' criteria teachers follow for making judgements around learning behaviours:

1	Pupil <i>always</i> listens well, tries hard, perseveres and responds well to setbacks.
2	Pupil <i>frequently</i> listens well, tries hard, perseveres and responds well to setbacks
3	Pupil <i>sometimes</i> listens well, tries hard, perseveres and responds well to setbacks
4	Pupil <i>occasionally</i> listens well, tries hard, perseveres and responds well to setbacks

Should you have any queries about your child's report, please contact their class teacher.
