Dear Families

We are pleased to announce that the Spring Term after school clubs at Fir Tree will begin week commencing Monday 28th April 2025 with the last week being week commencing Monday 7th July.

Once again we will be able to offer a range of clubs. As mentioned in previous communications, we, like all schools, face significant financial pressures. In order to meet the staffing costs of running a club, we will be charging £1.50 per session.

There will be a limit of 25 pupils to each club (with the exception of Kahoot), which may mean that not all children will get a place in a club this time round and we sincerely apologise for this. However there is a robust waiting list system in place so children who are not successful this time will be prioritised next term. Clubs will not be allocated on a first come first served basis and if we receive more than 25 applications for a club the names will be chosen randomly for fairness.

If your child would like to join a club, please complete the online form [here](#) by **no later than Tuesday 1st April midday**. Your child will be given a club confirmation slip on before the end of term and payment should be made via the School Gateway before the first club session begins to secure the place.

When children opt to join a club, they are expected to continue with it unless there is a compelling reason not to, in which case parents should approach me. If a child is unable to attend their club for one week, we ask that parents let the office staff know directly.

Our expectations of behaviour within clubs is high and we are sure our pupils will do us all proud. However, should a child make poor behavioural choices, we will address this with you.

We prefer that all children are collected by an adult/responsible person. A polite reminder that we expect children to be collected on time.
