Swimming Arrangements for Year 4

In line with National Curriculum expectations, our Year 4 pupils will be undertaking swimming sessions this term and we are pleased to be able to share the relevant details with you. The sessions will run each week, starting week commencing 21st April and the last sessions will be in week commencing 7th July (inclusive) at The Oratory School, Woodcote. This is a wonderful opportunity for the children to develop and hone their skills in a fantastic setting. Maple class will swim on Tuesday mornings and Ash class will swim on Wednesday mornings.

What will my child need to bring each week?

Each week the children will need to bring a swimming costume or trunks, towel and swimming hat. If your child requires any medication, please ensure that they bring it to school with their name on. Please note that children will need to remove their earrings/jewellery before they swim or cover earrings with waterproof plasters from home. If this causes difficulty, they should leave their earrings out on swimming days. Verrucas should be covered with either a normal or verruca sock. Goggles may only be worn if parents send a letter stating that they give permission for their child to wear goggles due to sensitivity to chlorine.

What is the cost?

Our school uses some of its Sports Premium funding to cover the significant cost of hiring the pool and its instructors. However, we would be very grateful for a voluntary contribution of £39.70 towards the cost of the travel for the 11 weeks. Should you find it helpful, we are able to offer you the opportunity to pay in instalments. It goes without saying that we are sorry that we are required to do this at a time when many families are experiencing difficulties associated with the cost of living.
