We need your help with the costumes. Your child has been told what character they are in the play. If there is any confusion, please check with your child's teacher. Please see below for information on the costumes required.

- **Guests/Shepherds/Joseph/ Announcer/Narrators/Musicians**
Long (adult sized) plain t-shirt, belt (string/rope), tea towel for headdress and something to keep it on the head (tights tied to the right size work well. You might want to wear shorts or leggings under your costume)
- **Innkeepers**
As above PLUS an apron
- **Mary**
Long blue t-shirt, shirt, belt (string/rope), tea towel for headdress and something to keep it on the head (tights tied to the right size work well)
- **Sheep**
Plain black and white trousers/leggings/t-shirt. We will make simple head bands in school.
- **Kings**
Long t-shirt, belt, make shift cloak. We will make simple crowns in school.
- **Donkey**
Brown, black or grey trousers and t-shirt. We will make or acquire a simple mask.
- **Angels**
Long (adult sized) plain t-shirt, tinsel belt. (Sorry, no wings or halos!)



*Please note – we do **not** want parents to go out and buy things specially. Please ask around and see what you can borrow.

*If a T-shirt is patterned, turning it inside out often works for plain.

Please can everyone bring their **named** costumes in a **named bag** on **Monday 4th December**. Also, please may everyone bring in a **small named torch** and one sock for our Nativity too.

Finally, please discuss any difficulties you have with the costumes with your class teacher by **Friday 1st December**.
