Dear Families

The class are settling in really well, especially so considering what a big change it is plus the unusually high temperatures in the first week back! We are very proud of how well they are settling and finding their feet.

I will update the class page as often as possible with pictures, news and curriculum information. Looking at the webpage with your child is a really good opportunity for children to share their learning with you and discuss what we have been doing.

In terms of homework, we will be sending out high frequency spelling words for you to work on at home with your child, tailored to your child's needs in the first instance. Please read daily to and with your child, books that interest them and make it a fun, enjoyable and quality time together.

Please also practise counting forwards and backwards from different starting points across tricky boundaries and develop fluency and confidence with number, plus practise number bonds to 10/20/50/100 depending on your child's ability.

We will not be sending out homework books this term or asking you to record anything formally for the whole of term one whilst children are settling into life at Fir Tree. We do welcome, however, 'Surprise Me' homework which is related to our learning and current project in school.

A word about 'Show and Tell' – generally we are keen to show things that are related to our project and keen to celebrate successes and achievements from outside school, but please avoid your child bringing in unrelated things to show as there is precious little time left in the school day.

On the website there is a rough idea of a timetable – it does change often! Sometimes things take longer or less time and unexpected things crop up, so we go with the flow. The timetable balances out over the course of a week or term, so please don't worry.

PE is Tuesday and Thursday this term.

Please always have a raincoat and sunhat in your child's bag – we do go out in the rain and sun!

We are committed to delivering education of the highest quality that supports and challenges all pupils to learn and progress in a secure and happy environment.



Forest sessions – please come dressed in usual school tops but trousers/leggings to stop legs being stung by nettles. Wellies will be necessary as weather deteriorates.

Now that your child is more familiar with Fir Tree, please feel free to leave your child in the playground when you drop them off in the mornings. An adult is always on duty.
