The programme of study in RE as set out in the Oxfordshire's Agreed syllabus 2015 for year 3-6 covers learning about different religions; traditions and beliefs



RE in Year 3

Across the year the children will be looking Christianity; Hinduism and Islam with a focus on beliefs and questions

In Christianity they will learn about:

God the Creator; Jesus -son of God; Ten Commandments; Jesus' teaching and parables; Church (xmas- birth of Christ); Pilgrimage sites; Holy Communion

In Hinduism they will learn about:

Shrine; Temple; Puja; Ganges; Varanasi; Benares); Divali; Holi; Kumbhamela

In Islam they will learn about:

God – Allah; Creator; Muhammad the Messenger; Five Pillars; Art and Architecture

RE in Year 4

Across the year the children will be looking Christianity; Islam and Judaisim with a focus on beliefs and questions

In Christianity they will learn about:

Baptism; Dedication; Advent; Christingle; Nativity; Confirmation; Weddings Jesus – early life, ministry, death, resurrection, ascension; Peter, Paul; Modern day examples

In Islam they will learn about:

Adhan / Aqiqah; (Naming Ceremony); Weddings

In Judaisim they will learn about:

God; Creator; Covenant; God given Torah; Messiah Synagogue; Jerusalem (Western Wall)

RE in Year 5

Across the year the children will be looking Christianity; Hinduism and Islam with a focus on beliefs and questions

In Christianity they will learn about:

Fairtrade; Christian Aid; Tear Fund; Cafod; Stewardship Clergy; Personal Bible study, family prayer, service to others; Modern monastic community

In Islam they will learn about:

Ramadan / Eid-UI-Fitr / Hajj / Eid-UI-Adha; Makkah, Medina, Mosque

In Judaism they will learn about:

Bar / Bat Mitzvah, Weddings; Rabbi; Shabbat; Passover; Purim; Shavuot; Rosh Hosanah

In Sikhism they will learn about:

Gurdwara; 5 k's Guru Nanak

RE in Year 6

Across the year the children will be looking Christianity; Islam and Judaism with a focus on beliefs and questions

In Christianity they will learn about:

Pentecost; Visual Symbols,; Symbolic titles given to Jesus; Art, Music and Architecture; Bible: Old and New Testaments

In Islam they will learn about:

Five Pillars; Sunnah; Dietary Laws; Modest dress; Imam; Family prayer; Service to others; Ummah

In Judaism they will learn about:

Ten Commandments; Mitzvot – good deeds; Daily prayer; Dietary Laws; Blessings; Abraham; Moses
